Project Profile

Shapiro Science Center at Brandeis University, a new 100,000 square foot laboratory building, designed by Payette, houses the National Center for Behavioral Genomics, as well as chemistry and biology teaching labs. Whitney Veigas was hired to design and supply the signs and donor plaques for this prestigious building.

Our Solution

Base building and ADA signs utilize plaques from the Identia Sign System, with extended aluminum back plates painted to match a corridor accent color. The donor plaques are etched satin zinc, appropriate for either interior or exterior mounting. The new building is connected to a number of existing science buildings, so a wayfinding map, with various links on different levels, was an essential part of the sign program.
